SCREEN FOR TB AT EACH VISIT ASK: IS THE PERSON LIVING WITH HIV...

Receiving Antiretroviral Treatment (ART)


NOT receiving Antiretroviral Treatment (ART)



mWRD

Chest X-Ray (CXR) (Abnormal)

C-Reactive Protein (CRP) (>5 mg/L)



MAY INDICATE TUBERCULOSIS (TB)

TB Negative (-) Screen

DIAGNOSTIC TEST TO CONFIRM TB

molecular WHO-recommended rapid diagnostic test (mWRD) or lateral flow urine lipoarabinomannan assay (LF-LAM)
